“We are appalled to learn about the shooting in Gugulethu in which seven people were killed and two others injured. SafeCitizen and its members send condolences to the families and friends of the victims, and trust that the police will track down the murderers and bring them to justice.”

“A community that stands together and looks out for each other can reduce the possibility and frequency of incidents like this by reporting suspicious activity and persons. Only by standing together as a lawfully armed society that cares about each other will we make our communities safer from crime and violence.”

“The police need our cooperation, and they rely on timeous information from the community to prevent crime and make arrests.”
